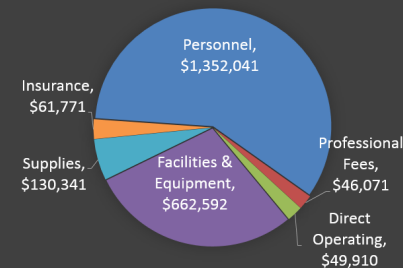
Thanks to our community of support, we were able to provide critical behavioral health and housing services to our community's most vulnerable residents.

### WHAT WE DO

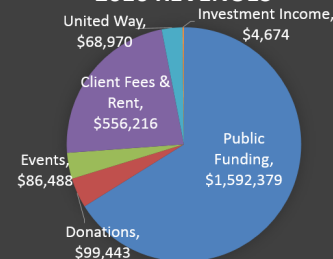
